Southwest Chapter agencies.

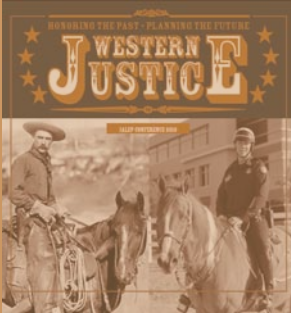
The theme and title for 2010 IALEP

2010 IALEP Conference visual displays!

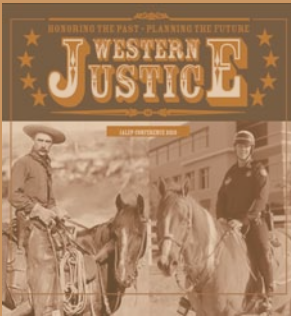

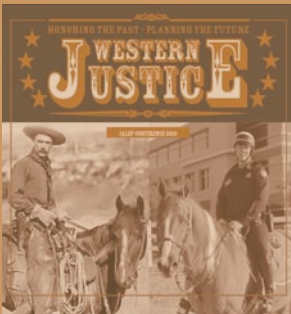
